CHRISTMAS GREETINGS FROM FR. JOACHIM ROBERT, FR. MICHAEL RAYMOND & CHS STAFF Dear people of CHS,

As we approach the feast of the Incarnation, a celebration so close to our Christian traditions, we wish to share with you some reflections as we draw close the Advent and beginning of Christmas season.

We recall the great prophet Isaiah accompanying us in our journey through Advent to the crib of Bethlehem.
