PREPARATION FOR REOPENING OF CHURCHES

Bishop Sebastian has given permission for the churches to be reopened in four-phases. The diocese has laid down guidelines for all to follow strictly. Here some brief details:

The number of attendees is limited to one third of the churches capacity and each attendee must sanitize their hands, undergo temperature scanning and mandatory registration before entering the church. Parish will also be doing manual registration for contact listing and tracing.

The age restrictions are for those 70 years and above and children 12 years and below. Therefore, only those aged **13-69** years are eligible according to calendar year 2020. Parishioners who have diabetes, cancer and other issues are **not encouraged** to attend and those who exhibit symptoms like fever, cough, respiratory issues and cold are **not allowed** to participate. Be assured that the parish is also concerned with your spiritual needs and we will respond accordingly but please bear with us and be patient.

We are permitted to have only one public mass during the period of RMC0, which is effective until 31st August 2020. The parish is making all the necessary preparation in compliance to the SOP given to ensure the safety of our parishioners.

Due to the gradual transition and limited resumption of public celebration of masses and restriction imposed on attendance, the Bishop will continue to dispense all the faithful from the obligation to attend mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation.
