

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) AT CATHOLIC CEMETRIES ON ALL SOULS DAY

Western Road Cemetery (As per SOP of MBPP)

- Visitors allowed by MBPP
 - 1st November 2020 (Sunday)
 - 2nd November 2020 (Monday) } **The cemetery will only be open for the TWO days**
from 7.00am to 5.00pm only. (Last entry at 4.30pm)
 - Not more than 500pax in the cemetery at one time – You are encouraged to offer Mass or attend the All Soul Day Mass and pray at home for the departed to avoid the crowding in cemetery.
- Strict observance of SOPs (physical distancing, wear face masks, temperature taking, check in using the MySejahtera QR code etc)
- Follow strictly the instructions of the MBPP.
- The Priests of Penang Island will bless the cemetery without the usual presence of the public gathering.

Kelawai Road Catholic Cemetery (Follow the SOP of IC Church)

- Normal day visits is from 8.00am – 12.30pm
- 31st October 2020 (Saturday) – 2nd November 2020 (Monday) – visiting hours are from 8.00am- 6.00pm (Last entry will be at 5.00pm)
- Not more than 150pax in the cemetery at one time
- Parking is at IC Church compound or nearby parking lots.
- No vehicles will be allowed into the cemetery compound during the three days.
- Strict observance of SOPs (physical distancing, wear face masks, temperature taking, check in using the MySejahtera QR code etc)
- You are requested to leave the Kelawai Road cemetery immediately after paying your respects to avoid congregating and breaching the social distancing rules.
- The Priests of Penang Island will bless the cemetery without the usual presence of the public gathering.

Penang Road Heritage Cemetery (As per SOP of City Parish)

- Opening Hour 2nd November 2020 (Monday) - 8.00am – 12.30pm
- Not more than 20 visitors in the cemetery at one time
- All the SOPs need to be followed (physical distancing, mask, temperature taking, check in using the MySejahtera QR code etc)
- The Parish Priest of City Parish will bless the cemetery without the usual presence of the public gathering.
