

Dear Parishioners of CHS,

Greetings of Peace.

With the worsening of the Covid-19 situation, the parish will follow the below precautionary measures with effect from 9 May 2021 until further notice.

1. The capacity for each mass is reduced to 200 persons

2. Ministry meetings are to be held online. Where in-person (face to face) meeting is needed, it will be limited to not more than 8 persons.

3. Catechism and RCIA classes are to be conducted online.

Ministry leaders can contact Parish Office for online (Zoom) meeting arrangement. We thank you for your kind understanding and cooperation in following these precautionary measures to ensure the safety of everyone.

We seek your cooperation to kindly remain at home and refrain from attending physical gatherings and masses if you are feeling unwell, have any symptoms of this virus, been exposed to any persons suspected with this virus or having family members undergoing home-quarantine. This simple act of charity for ourselves and for others will break the chain of transmission.

Let us continue to be vigilant and responsible by avoiding unnecessary risks.

Thank you for your earnest prayers for this Covid-19 situation, the parish and for all. Thank you for standing in the gap; for prayers do the things our hands cannot do.
