The Catholic Bishops Conference of Malaysia (CBCM) together with other religious organisations and NGOs have given their endorsement and support to the Malaysia Solidarity Fund Against Covid-19 which was initiated by the Tzu Chi Foundation Malaysia. This is an emergency fund in response to the urgent call for help from our public hospitals and health care professionals for the supply of varied medical equipment to cope with the huge number of Covid-19 patients.
