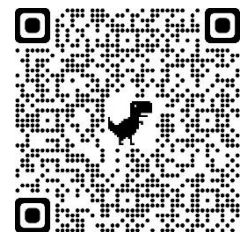
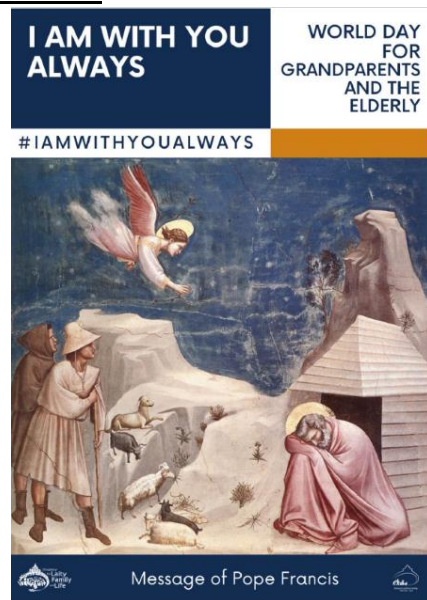
1. Inform CHS office of any families that need help in your neighborhood.
