In consideration that many parishioners who are working have not been able to receive the sacrament of Holy Communion, CHS will be organizing drive thru Communion Service on September 16th Malaysia Day. There will be total of 4 sessions 5.00pm to 7.30pm, accommodating up to 20 cars for each session. Parishioners are to remain in the vehicle throughout the service. It is important that parishioners plan to arrive strictly between the Gate Opens time.

WHO MAY APPLY?

- Baptized Catholic parishioners who have a Low Risk No Symptom Covid-19 risk status and are fully vaccinated are welcomed to come to church to receive Holy Communion after attending online Mass at home.



- The public advisory continues to discourage children below 12 years old, senior citizens above the age of 60 and those with chronic illness from public gathering. If you are planning to come, please consult your family members and weigh the risk for yourself and others.

WHO CANNOT ATTEND?

- Those who are unwell or exhibiting symptoms / infections such as cough, fever, sore throat, respiratory issues, flu or cold are not permitted.
- Those who are **NOT** showing Low Risk No Symptom Covid-19 risk status.
- Those who are under investigation or home quarantine (if there are members in your household that are under home quarantine or investigation, you are not allowed to attend).

PREPARATION DETAILS

- There is only limited allocation per session for communion session.
- Registration will be through Event Brite. Links for registration will be published through the normal Whatsapp communication channel.
- Registration will automatically close when the maximum number allocated is reached.

PLANS TO WELCOME YOU BACK FOR WEEKDAY MASSES

In light of revised guidelines under the current Majlis Keselamatan Negara's Standard Operation Procedure (MKN SOP), the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit is in the midst of planning the opening of weekday Masses to accommodate 30 persons per Mass. Subject to any revisions in the MKN SOP, the following are the details and guidelines for you to take note:-

Masses will be held on weekdays (Monday to Friday)

**Admission only for those registered for Weekday Mass

- Morning: 7.00am (Mass) in the chapel.
- Evening: 6.10pm (Vespers) / 6.30pm (Mass) in the church.

Guidelines

- Allocation of Mass seats will be on a first-come-first-served basis. However, a few allocations will be prioritized for those on duty.
- Parishioners may attend 1 Mass only per week as we need to consider those who have not attended any physical Mass during the week. **Parishioners wishing to attend more Masses could be placed under waiting list, to be called if there is available places left.
- If any family member in your household is unwell or under quarantine, kindly refrain from attending Masses.
- If your MySejahtera Covid-19 Risk Status does not show "Low Risk", kindly refrain from attending Masses.
- The Masses are only opened to parishioners who are fully vaccinated. Persons are deemed to have completed their Covid-19 vaccinations only after 14 days from the date they received their second dose. Parishioners will be required to show proof via their MySejahtera application or their vaccination card that they have completed their Covid-19 vaccinations.
- Parishioners aged 70 and above, or below 18 are advised to continue to follow online Masses from home.
- Booking:** Kindly call the Parish Office @ 04-6566681 to reserve / confirm your seat for the Mass. You will be notified of the availability.
- Cancellation:** Kindly call the Parish Office at least one day in advance if you are unable to attend Mass so that allocation may be given to other parishioners.

These **procedures and restrictions** are important to protect ourselves and each other during this time of coping with the coronavirus pandemic.

- Please wear a mask** when coming to church or attending Mass in the church.
- Please observe proper physical distancing** upon entering and exiting the church.
- Please leave immediately after Mass**, avoid gathering before and after Mass.
