DAILY MASS FROM OCT 18TH TO OCT 29TH (MONDAY TO FRIDAY)

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ, we are happy to inform that CHS will be opening Daily Mass (Mon-Fri) starting Oct-18th to our parishioners, limit to 30 participants per day. Kindly plan to arrive by 6pm as vesper starts at 610pm. To safeguard our parishioners, kindly strictly follow the criteria below for eligibility to come for Daily Mass.

WHO MAY ATTEND

- Baptized Catholic parishioners who have a Low Risk No Symptom Covid-19 risk status and are fully vaccinated (subject to SOP changes) are welcomed to call Church Office 04-6584909 to register for Daily MASS. Please exercise charity to allow others to receive Holy Communion by only registering once a week. Priority will be given to those who have not come for Daily Mass in the current week.
- The public advisory continues to discourage children below 12 years old, senior citizens above the age of 60 and those with chronic illness from public gathering. If you are planning to come, please consult your family members and weigh the risk for yourself and others.

WHO CANNOT ATTEND?

- Those who are unwell or exhibiting symptoms / infections such as cough, fever, sore throat, respiratory issues, flu or cold are not permitted.
- Those who are NOT showing Low Risk No Symptom Covid-19 risk status.
- Those who are NOT fully vaccinated (must be more than 14 days after 2nd Dose)
- Those who are under investigation or home quarantine (if there are members in your household that are under home quarantine or investigation, you are not allowed to attend).

3. Registration will automatically close when the maximum number allocated is reached.
4. For the safety of our volunteers and parishioners, kindly adhere strictly to the SOPs i.e. wearing mask and remain in the vehicle throughout the duration of the service. All parishioners are to turn off the engine during the Communion Service.
5. Parishioners are requested kindly requested to utilize the online facility for love offering to avoid handling of cash during the Drive In Communion Service

Dear clergy, religious and lay faithful of Penang Island:

RESUMPTION OF PUBLIC MASSES UNDER THE NATIONAL RECOVERY PLAN (NRP) FROM 30TH OCTOBER 2021

The recent improvement of the ongoing pandemic situation in our nation has seen an ease of restrictions and a return to some form of normalcy, in addition to the revision of SOPs applicable to non-Muslim places of worship in the state of Penang under the National Recovery Plan (NRP) Phase 2.

Upon agreement of the parish priests from the respective parishes in the Penang Island Deanery, we hereby declare a **resumption of public Masses (Weekday/Weekend) in parishes located within Penang Island commencing from 30th October 2021**. To ensure proper distancing at each public Mass, the total number of persons allowed will not exceed one third of the full capacity of the church.

Those who wish to attend public Masses should meet several requirements as per below:

- Fully vaccinated as per the SOP of MKN (Completed at least 14 days after 2 doses of Pfizer/AstraZeneca/Sinovac or 28 days after 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson/Cansino)
- MySejahtera status as "Low Risk/ Casual Contact with no symptom"

The celebration of Sacraments such as weddings, funerals and confessions are permitted and subject to the capacity and guidelines of each parish. The faithful are advised to contact their respective parish priests to make the necessary arrangements.

We wish to assure that all required measures will be in place to protect both the physical and spiritual welfare of the lay faithful. We seek the kind cooperation and forbearance of all parishioners as individual parishes begin preparations to reopen our doors safely. Let us give praise to God for the opportunity to once again gather as a community of faith, and turn to Our Lady for protection, health and safety from the pandemic.
