

- 1. Baptized Catholic parishioners who have a Low Risk No Symptom / Covid-19 risk status and are fully vaccinated (subject to SOP changes) are welcomed. Please exercise charity to allow others to receive Holy Communion by only registering once a week.
- 2. The public advisory continues to discourage children below 12 years old, senior citizens above the age of 60 and those with chronic illness from public gathering. If you are planning to come, please consult your family members and weigh the risk for yourself and others.

WHO CANNOT ATTEND?

- Those who are unwell or exhibiting symptoms / infections such as cough, fever, sore throat, respiratory issues, flu or cold are not permitted.
- Those who are NOT showing Low Risk No Symptom Covid-19 risk status.
- Those who are NOT fully vaccinated (must be more than 14 days after 2nd Dose)
- Those who are under investigation or home quarantine (if there are members in your household that are under home quarantine or investigation, you are not allowed to attend).

DRIVE-IN COMMUNION SERVICE

CHS will continue with the communion service on Sunday Nov-7th to reach out to our parishioners & families within the same household to receive the sacrament of Holy Communion. For families within the same household, adults & children ages 18 and above must be fully vaccinated. There will be a total of 2 sessions from 5.15pm to 5.45pm, accommodating up to 20 cars for each session. Additional sessions from 5.45pm to 6.45pm may be opened should there be overflow. Parishioners are to remain in the vehicle throughout the service. It is important that parishioners plan to arrive not earlier than 5 minutes before their registered sessions.

WHO CANNOT ATTEND?

- 1. Those who are unwell or exhibiting symptoms / infections such as cough, fever, sore throat, respiratory issues, flu or cold are not permitted.
- 2. Those who are **NOT** showing Low Risk No Symptom Covid-19 risk status.
- 3. Those who are under investigation or home quarantine (if there are members in your household that are under home quarantine or investigation, you are not allowed to attend).

PREPARATION DETAILS

- 1. There is only limited allocation per session for communion session.
- 2. Registration will be through Event Brite. Links for registration will be published through the normal Whatsapp communication channel.
- 3. Registration will automatically close when the maximum number allocated is reached.
- 4. For the safety of our volunteers and parishioners, kindly adhere strictly to the SOPs i.e. wearing mask and remain in the vehicle throughout the duration of the service. All parishioners are to turn off the engine during the Communion Service.
- 5. Parishioners are requested kindly requested to utilize the online facility for love offering to avoid handling of cash during the Drive In Communion Service

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (S.O.P) FOR ATTENDING 'ALL SOUL DAY' AND ALL SAINT DAY 'EVENTS AT CHRISTIAN CEMETERY, JALAN UTAMA, PENANG DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL RECOVERY PLAN (NCR) - PHASE 3

- Event permission from 30th Oktober 2021 to 2nd November 2021 (Saturday to Tuesday) only.
- 2. Time limit from 7.00 am to 5.00 pm (last time to enter the cemetery is at 4.30 pm)
- Capacity of only 1,000 people at a time.
- Visitors MUST undergo a body temperature check, record attendance manually or are encouraged to use a QR Code scan via MySejahtera application or other appropriate application.
- Only visitors who have completed 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine are allowed to enter the Cemetery.
- While waiting for their turn at the screening counter, guests comply with the <u>physical</u> <u>distance of at least 1 meter</u> by following the markings set by the Council.
- Those who show signs of cough, cold, shortness of breath and body temperature <u>above</u> 37.5 ° Celsius are not allowed to enter.
- Individuals from chronic diseases, the elderly, infants and children are <u>advised not to</u> <u>participate</u> in or attend this event.
- Visitors MUST wear a face mask at all times in the cemetery and need to clean their hands (hand sanitize).
- Comply with the instructions of the security personnel of the Council on duty.
- Vehicles are not allowed into the Christian Cemetery.
- Take the position as marked or set by the Council.
- 13 Please avoid close conversation
- Maintain the position of physical distance 1 meter and do not gather while performing cleaning activities or meditating in an orderly manner and reduce communication during the activity.
- Not crowded in any space in this cemetery.
- 16. It is forbidden to gather outside the cemetery before or after the event.
- Leave the cemetery in order and not crowded after the event.



SOP Guidelines for Kelawai Road Catholic Cemetery (KRCC) during ALL SOULS DAY 2021

1. Date: Saturday 30^{th.} October 2021 to Tuesday 2nd November 2021.

2. Time: Our opening hours for these 4 days will be from 8am to 6pm.

3. Entrance: At main gate only.

4. Last entry: into KRCC will be at 5pm on these four days.

- Parking: All vehicles can be parked at our Church compound or nearby parking lots. No vehicles will be allowed into the KRCC cemetery compound during these four days.
- 6. **Capacity:** A maximum number of **150 visitors** will be allowed into the KRCC cemetery compound at any one time. Please follow the instructions of the security personnel on duty.
- 7. To enter KRCC: you must be fully vaccinated as per SOP of MKN (evidenced by Vaccination Digital Certificate or Vaccination Cards showing that you have completed at least 14 days after two doses of Pfizer / Astra Zeneca / Sinovac or 28 days after one dose of Johnson & Johnson / Cansino).
- Check in: All visitors must scan their MySejahtera QR code or manually record their personal details. They will also be required to temperature scan and sanitise their hands prior to entering KRCC compound.
- 9. Face mask: Wear your face mask at all times while in the KRCC cemetery compound.
- 10. Social Distance: All visitors are to maintain a 1 meter Social Distancing. This includes when you are queuing to enter the KRCC or while in the KRCC compound.
- 11. Congregating: Kindly leave the KRCC cemetery immediately after paying your respects to avoid congregating and breaching the social distancing rules.

12. Restrictions:

- Those with symptoms like fever (> 37.5°C), cough, cold and respiratory issues (e.g. shortness
 of breath) are not allowed entry into KRCC.
- Close Contacts; Persons under Surveillance (PUS) and those under quarantine are strictly prohibited from entering KRCC.
- 13. The Priests will bless the cemetery on 2nd. November.
