### DRIVE-IN COMMUNION SERVICE

CHS will continue with the communion service on Sunday Nov-14th to reach out to our parishioners & families within the same household to receive the sacrament of Holy Communion. For families within the same household. adults & children ages 18 and above must be fully vaccinated. There will be 2 sessions starting 5.15pm/5.30pm, accommodating up to 20 cars for each session. Parishioners are to remain in the vehicle throughout the service. It is important that parishioners plan to arrive not earlier than 5 minutes before their registered sessions.

- For the safety of our volunteers and parishioners, kindly adhere strictly to the SOPs i.e. wearing mask and remain in the vehicle throughout the duration of the service. All parishioners are to turn off the engine during the Communion Service.
- 5. Parishioners are requested kindly requested to utilize the online facility for love offering to avoid handling of cash during the Drive In Communion Service


