

WHO MAY ATTEND

- 1. Parishioners who have a Low Risk / Casual Contact with no symptom Covid-19 risk status and are fully vaccinated (subject to SOP changes) are welcomed.
- The public advisory continues to discourage children below 12 years old, senior citizens above the age of 60 and those with chronic illness from public gathering. If you are planning to come, please consult your family members and weigh the risk for yourself and others.

WHO CANNOT ATTEND?

- Those who are unwell or exhibiting symptoms / infections such as cough, fever, sore throat, respiratory issues, flu or cold are not permitted.
- 2. Those who are NOT showing Low Risk / Casual Contact with no symptom Covid-19 risk
- 3. Those who are NOT fully vaccinated (must be more than 14 days after 2nd Dose)

Those who are under investigation or home quarantine (if there are members in your household that are under home guarantine or investigation, you are not allowed to attend).

NOTICE

With the new revision on the abolishment of the temperature control and log books, our position to ensure a safe environment for parishioners to attend Mass is severely compromised. The only alternative we can turn to, is to yourselves, as parishioners of CHS to take responsibility and take care of each other (*Kita jaga kita*). The new Omicron variant is highly contagious and most of the time, those tested positive do not have any fever or any of the usual symptoms of the Delta variant. As such, we appeal to all to refrain from coming for Mass especially if you have the following symptoms:-

sore throat, runny nose, persistent cough or any other symptoms related to this pandemic, irrespective of your self-test result. This would greatly help us make our church safe for us to gather together as one body to worship Him and receive the Eucharist.

COMING BACK TO CHURCH - Catechism of the Catholic Church 1324-1327 defines the Eucharist as the source and summit of Christian Life. We need to receive the Eucharist to strengthen ourselves and persevere through the trials of life. We cannot receive the Eucharist virtually and with the majority of parishioners fully vaccinated, we are encouraging all parishioners to come back and worship our Lord as one body especially on Sundays as it is a day of obligation. The dispensation was given at a time when Covid-19 was taking many lives and no vaccines were available. The situation is different now. If you are fully vaccinated, and especially if you are going to work every day, eating out, going to the market or mall, visiting relatives during CNY, you should be able to come and worship our Lord in church on Sundays as well.

GIVE BLOOD, GIVE LOVE

- 8. Premature infants and mothers with excessive blood loss due to childbirth

It's all up to you! The 8 kinds of people mentioned above are all looking forward to your help. They also hope to live a normal life, to continue their life and to continue to be with their loved ones. To get to this point, they do need your help and mine i.e. our precious blood donation. Especially during this Lent, it's a small contribution we can make to others.
