INTERNAL CIRCULATION ONLY BUL 51/2024 In Micah, we hear of this obscure place, Bethlehem-Ephrathah. Even the prophet says the place is too small to be among the clans of Judah. Yet from here shall come forth, the One who is to be ruler in Israel; and whose origin is from old.

Then, we are transported to the scene of Mary hastening to visit her cousin, Elizabeth who is with child. The little Judean town where Elizabeth stays is not even named. Two mothers-to-be meet, and the child in Elizabeth's womb leaps for joy. Elizabeth recognises the divine life in Mary's womb and she bursts into praise, proclaiming, 'Why should I be honoured with a visit from the mother of my Lord?'

Such is the joy that comes forth when one has the presence of the Lord. And the bearer of the Lord's presence is His Mother. Mary takes the initiative to be of service to her aged cousin. In essence, Mary is showing us the way. Christ is going to live his life amongst us when he is incarnated. His will be a birth of poverty ending on death on the Cross. It is not possible to celebrate Christmas without having to think of Christ's Cross and redemption.

In the letter to the Hebrews, the writer says that God is not keen in sacrifices and oblations of animals and he takes no pleasure in holocausts. Instead, God prepares a body for his Son, one that will be offered unconditionally back to the Father.

Here I am, Lord, I come to do your Will. This is what Jesus wants us to imitate Him. To do the Will of the Father, totally and unconditionally. His Mother sets the pace when she answers the angel and says, 'I am the Handmaid of the Lord, let it be done to me, according to thy Will.'
