Our prayer has to be: "Speak Lord, your servant is listening". It is this prayer of the heart that begins the journey to the inside (in this season of Lent) and seeks answers to two fundamental questions in life: Who am I? Where am I going in Life?

Only when we understand that Baptism gives us an inner experience of the foundational encounter with the God of Love, as shown and expressed by the parents and gradually the family as the Domestic Church. The outward public "sign" (Rite) of Baptism must be accompanied by the more significant nourishing of the "Inward Grace" in order for Faith to grow with sensitivity to be in a life-long endeavour to discover and re-discover, listen and listen again to the "Calling of the Lord" and thus be able to respond to our Vocation as Christians and also for the Church as a People of God.

Baptism is not the beginning of our membership in the Church because receiving this Sacrament we were taught of "the outward sign of an inward grace". Membership in an organisation is very different from being an integral part of a human body with a divine inner life: our Faith informs us that this Body is the body of Christ, who was risen from Death to be the Church as the People of God. This Church has a history and memory but is always open to reinterpreting the story of Jesus to be relevant to the people of today.

- Computation and remittance of Solidarity fund and other pass through amounts to Diocese through on-line banking system
- Compiling and filing all source documents supporting transactions vendor invoices, utility bills, banking in slips, bank statement etc and inputting into Arkdios system.
- Reconciliation of Bank Statements for all bank accounts including fixed deposits.
- Input all financial transactions (including petty cash payments) into Arkdios Accounting system promptly
- Preparation of monthly accounts
- Managing renewal of Parish Insurances
