his week, we continue with the theme of hearing the "cry of the Earth and the cry of the poor" (Laudato Si' #49). The first reading and the Gospel are warnings to those who have wealth to hear the cry of the poor.



Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions.

Luke 12: 15

At the global level, the richest 1% in Global North countries extracted USD 30 million an hour from the Global South through the financial system in 2023. Global North countries control 69% of global wealth despite making up just 21% of the global population.

Wages in the Global South are 87-95% lower than wages in the Global North for work of equal skill. Despite contributing 90% of the labour that drives the global economy, workers in low- and middle-income countries receive only 21% of global income.

At the individual level, the richest 1% have more wealth than the bottom 95% of the world's population put together. The richest 10% of people on the planet are responsible for about 50% of greenhouse gas emissions-within this, the richest 1% contribute 16%—while 50% of the world's poorest are responsible for only 8%.

Those who "have" are clearly driving the climate crisis and doing "too little too late" to cut down excessiveness in their lifestyles. Our consumption decisions are literally life and death ones at this point of time in history. We don't have to be in the richest 10% bracket to make a difference. Every one of our decisions matters. We are accountable for our own acts and omissions. Every fraction of a degree of increased global warming will affect billions of lives, especially those of the poor who have nothing to buffer them from the impacts of worsening floods, storms, droughts and other climate impacts. In addition, we must be ready to "fight the good fight of faith" (today's second reading) and persist in our advocacy for justice for the poor and all creation.

2. THE FIRST CLASS RELICS OF SAINT ELENA GUERRA & SAINT CARLO ACUTIS | 5 OCTOBER 2025

In the last Parish Pastoral Assembly on 13 October 2024, the Parish initiated the project to setup the Saints Corner, where First Class Relics of Saint Elena Guerra and Saint Carlo Acutis will be placed. We are blessed to have received these relics. They will be placed in the reliquary in CHS Church on 5 October 2025, during the 10.30 am English Mass.

After Communion in that Mass, there will be a Paraliturgy, where the relics will be displayed at the foot of the Sanctuary, and the congregation present will be invited to come out in procession to venerate the relics. This is followed by the Rite of Placement of Relics into the Reliquary. All Parishioners are encouraged to come and celebrate the 10.30am Mass on Sunday, 5 October 2025 and give praises to God for the gift of sainthood in the persons of our beloved Saints Elena and Carlo.

Information about the Saints

Saint Elena Guerra was foundress of the Oblate Sisters of The Holy Spirit in Italy (Sisters of St. Zita). A friend of Pope Leo XIII and the teacher of St. Gemma Galgani, she was known for her spiritual writings and her passionate devotion to the Holy Spirit. She is now known as "an Apostle of the Holy Spirit". She was canonized by Pope Francis on 20 October 2024.

Saint Carlo Acutis, the First Millennial Saint, was known for his passion for the Eucharist. When many of his contemporaries were walking away from the Mass, Carlo found something beautiful in it that attracted him, something divine that he experienced. For Carlo, the Eucharist was a threshold experience that enabled him to transcend the border of this world and touch a world beyond. He was canonized by Pope Leo XIV on 7 September 2025.


