

n the Gospel today, we hear the apostles cry out for an increase in faith. This prompts Jesus to teach about faith and service to God. It is a dialogue about what it means to be His disciple. Jesus assures us that faith, no matter how small, will enable us, as followers of Jesus, to do amazing things. But Jesus also caution that we should know our place in God's plans. We are to understand ourselves as servants to God and His plans.

Even when God works wonders through us, with our mustard seed-sized faith, we are to know that our part in God's plans is His grace to us—nothing more, nothing less. When we cooperate with God, what we do is nothing more than our obligation to God as faithful stewards. And our faith enables us to believe that what we have offered in service to God, as his servants, can produce fruits a hundredfold. (Paraphrased from Loyola Press website)

It is with this disposition that all leaders in Church are called to serve. As in Matthew 20:25-26, Jesus said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant..."

Today also marks World Migration and Refugee Sunday. Pope Leo XIV in his recent message on 25 July laments the current global situation marked by wars, violence, injustice and extreme weather events, which force millions of people to leave their homelands in search of refuge elsewhere. "In a world darkened by war and injustice, even when all seems lost, migrants and refugees stand as messengers of hope. Their courage and tenacity bear heroic testimony to a faith that sees beyond what our eyes can see and gives them the strength to defy death on the various contemporary migration routes."

Let us pray that as we journey through life, we may continue to be faithful stewards in our service to God and to one another bringing hope to the world. Even when injustice come our way, let us hold on to the Lord's promise in the 1st reading that all things will be fulfilled, "...if it comes slowly, wait, for come it will, without fail." •



THE FIRST CLASS RELICS OF SAINT ELENA GUERRA & SAINT CARLO ACUTIS | 5 OCTOBER 2025

In the last Parish Pastoral Assembly on 13 October 2024, the Parish initiated the project to setup the Saints Corner, where First Class Relics of Saint Elena Guerra and Saint Carlo Acutis will be placed. We are blessed to have received these relics. They will be placed in the reliquary in CHS Church on 5 October 2025, during the 10.30 am English Mass. After Communion in that Mass, there will be a Paraliturgy, where the relics will be displayed at the foot of the Sanctuary, and the congregation present will be invited to come out in procession to venerate the relics. This is followed by the Rite of Placement of Relics into the Reliquary. All Parishioners are encouraged to come and celebrate the 10.30am Mass on Sunday, 5 October 2025 and give praises to God for the gift of sainthood in the persons of our beloved Saints Elena and Carlo.

Information about the Saints

Saint Elena Guerra was foundress of the Oblate Sisters of The Holy Spirit in Italy (Sisters of St. Zita). A friend of Pope Leo XIII and the teacher of St. Gemma Galgani, she was known for her spiritual writings and her passionate devotion to the Holy Spirit. She is now known as "an Apostle of the Holy Spirit". She was canonized by Pope Francis on 20 October 2024.

Saint Carlo Acutis, the First Millennial Saint, was known for his passion for the Eucharist. When many of his contemporaries were walking away from the Mass, Carlo found something beautiful in it that attracted him, something divine that he experienced. For Carlo, the Eucharist was a threshold experience that enabled him to transcend the border of this world and touch a world beyond. He was canonized by Pope Leo XIV on 7 September 2025.


